Champ's Tips for Safe Summer Fun

Sun Safety

While Champ has lots of fur to protect his skin from the sun, he wants you to remember to protect your skin when you are outside playing. His friends at the New York State Department of Health told him that whether you are swimming or just running around outside with your friends, to make sure you ask an adult for sunscreen with an SPF (sun protection factor) of 15 or higher. It is also a good idea to play in the shade whenever you can, especially between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm when the sun is at its hottest. Also, remember to drink lots of water on hot summer days!

Did you know that even when it is cloudy outside you can get a sunburn? So remember, no matter what it looks like outside, make sure you put your sunscreen on all the parts of your skin that will not be covered by your clothes. Champ thinks it is a good idea to ask an adult to help you put the sunscreen on your face so you do not get any in your eyes. That can sting! Lots of his kid buddies also wear hats for

After swimming and playing, remember to help the adults put away all your pool toys so no one gets hurt.
